• Uganda

Uganda is home to the second largest lake (Lake Victoria) in the world. During four clinics in January, **Partner 135** treated 3,169 patients; 1,834 received eyeglasses through the vision clinic and 1,063 committed their lives to Christ. • Panama

Although Panama is the richest country in Latin America, poverty remains in the remote areas of the country. In February, **Fairview Village Church**, from Eagleville, PA, sent a mission team and provided over 360 people with glasses in the five days of clinic, with many committing their lives to Christ.



• Moldova

Sandwiched between the countries of Romania and Ukraine, this country of 2.6 million people is one of the poorest countries in Europe. The **Global Signet Group** from Wichita, KS provided over 125 eyeglasses during their March clinic.
